
Hon'ble Prime Minister Mr. Narendra Modi addresses 9th G20 Parliamentary Speakers' Summit





Hon'ble Prime Minister Mr. Narendra Modi inaugurated the 9th G20 Parliamentary Speakers' Summit (P20) at Yashobhoomi, New Delhi on 13th October 2023. The summit was hosted by the Parliament of India under the broader framework of India's G20 Presidency with the theme of 'Parliaments for One Earth, One Family, One Future'. Addressing the gathering, the Prime Minister welcomed the dignitaries to the G20 Parliamentary Speakers' Summit on behalf of 140 crore citizens of India. "The Summit is a 'Maha Kumbh' of all Parliamentary practices from across the globe", the Prime Minister remarked. Underlining that all the delegates present today hold the experience of the Parliamentary framework from different countries, Prime Minister expressed great satisfaction with today's event.

The Prime Minister emphasized that the P20 Summit is taking place on the land which is not only known as the mother of democracy but is also the largest democracy in the world. As representatives of different Parliaments from around the world, the Prime Minister underlined the importance of debates and deliberations as he mentioned accurate examples of such debates from history. He informed that assemblies and committees have found a mention in the five-thousand-year-old Vedas and scriptures of India, where collective decisions were made for the betterment of society. Speaking about Rigveda, India's oldest scripture, the Prime Minister recited a Sanskrit shloka which means 'We must walk together, speak together and that our minds must be conjoined'. He informed that issues related to the village level were resolved by indulging in debates which became a source of great amazement for the Greek ambassador Megasthenes who wrote about it in great detail. The Prime Minister also touched upon a 9th-century inscription in Tamil Nadu which elaborates upon rules and codes of village legislatives. "The 1200-year-old inscription also mentions the rules for disqualification of a member", Prime Minister added. Speaking about the Anubhav Mantappa tradition which



has been going on since the 12th century in India, and years before the Magna Carta came into existence, the Prime Minister informed that discussions were encouraged where people from every caste, creed and religion were free to express their thoughts. "The Anubhav Mantappa initiated by Jagatguru Basweshwara makes India proud even today", the Prime Minister remarked as he underlined that the journey of India from 5000-year-old scriptures till today is a heritage of Parliamentary traditions not just for India but the entire world.


The Prime Minister also dwelled on the modernization of the election process. The use of EVMs since the last 25 years has brought transparency and efficiency to the election process as election results come within hours of the start of counting. He informed that 1 billion people will participate in the general election next year and invited the delegates to witness the elections.


The Prime Minister highlighted the unwavering faith of the citizens in the parliamentary traditions of India and credited its diversity and vibrancy. "We have people of every faith here. Hundreds of types of food, ways of living, languages, dialects", the Prime Minister said. He informed that India has more than 900 TV channels in India in 28 languages to provide real-time information to the people, more than 33 thousand different newspapers are published in about 200 languages, and about 3 billion users on different social media platforms. Prime Minister emphasized the huge flow of information and the level of freedom of speech in India. "In this world of the 21st century, this vibrancy of India, unity in diversity, is our greatest strength. This vibrancy inspires us to fight every challenge and solve every difficulty together", Prime Minister added.

Concluding the address, the Prime Minister underlined that there can be no better medium than public participation to deal with the world's challenges. "I have always believed that governments are formed by majority, but the country is run by consensus. Our parliaments and this P20 forum can also strengthen this sentiment", the Prime Minister said and expressed confidence that the efforts to improve this world through debate and deliberations will definitely be successful.

Hon'ble Prime Minister Mr. Narendra Modi participates in Rashtriya Ekta Diwas celebrations in Kevadia, Gujarat





Hon'ble Prime Minister Mr. Narendra Modi participated in the Rashtriya Ekta Diwas-related events on 31st October 2023. He paid homage to Sardar Patel at the Statue of Unity on his birth anniversary. Addressing the gathering, the Prime Minister remarked that Rashtriya Ekta Diwas celebrates the strength of the unity of India's youth and its warriors. "In a way, I can witness the form of mini India", the Prime Minister emphasized. He underlined that even though the languages, states and traditions are different, every person in the country is weaved in the strong thread of unity. "The beads are plenty, but the garland is one. Even though we are diverse, we are united", he said.

The Prime Minister reiterated that the next 25 years are the most important 25 years of this century for the nation as India is to turn into a prosperous and developed country during this period. He called for the same spirit of dedication for the country that was witnessed in the 25 years just before the Independence. He noted the growing profile of India in the world. "We feel proud as we are taking the stature of the biggest democracy to a new height", he said. He mentioned India's robust position in security, economy, science, indigenous defence production, and global corporate leadership being provided by Indians in key global companies and sports. Referring to the pledge of moving forward and abandoning the mentality of slavery, Prime Minister said that India is growing as well as preserving its heritage." He mentioned the removal of colonial insignia from the Navy Flag, weeding out unnecessary laws from colonial times, IPC being replaced and the Netaji statue adorning India Gate replacing colonial representatives.

Referring to the Iron Man Sardar Saheb's unwavering concern for internal security, the Prime Minister listed the steps taken in the last 9 years in this regard and how the challenges are being firmly met by depriving the forces of destruction with the success that they enjoyed earlier. He stressed the need to remain vigilant against the attacks on the unity of the nation.

The Prime Minister said that today's India is the new India where every citizen is brimming with confidence. He stressed ensuring that this confidence continues and the feeling of unity remains the same. He concluded the address by paying a humble tribute to Sardar Patel on behalf of the citizens and conveyed his best wishes on Rashtriya Ekta Diwas.

India Mobile Congress (IMC) is the largest telecom, media, and technology forum in Asia to be held from 27th to 29th October 2023 with the theme 'Global Digital Innovation'. The IMC 2023 aims to strengthen India's position as a developer, manufacturer, and exporter of key cutting-edge technologies. During the program, the Prime Minister awarded 100 '5G Use Case Labs' to educational institutions across the country.

Addressing the gathering, the Prime Minister said that in the changing times of the 21st century, this event has the power to change the lives of crores of people. Underling the fast pace of technology, the Prime Minister said "The future is here and now". He praised the exhibition placed for the occasion to provide glimpses of the future in

telecom, technology and connectivity. 
Hon'ble Prime Minister Mr. Narendra launches India's first Regional Rapid Transit System

Hon'ble Prime Minister Mr. Narendra Modi inaugurated the priority section of Delhi-Ghaziabad-Meerut RRTS Corridor at Sahibabad RapidX Station in Ghaziabad, Uttar Pradesh today. He also flagged off the Namo Bharat RapidX train connecting Sahibabad to Duhai Depot, marking the launch of the Regional Rapid Transit System (RRTS) in India. Prime Minister dedicated to the nation, two stretches of east-west corridor of Bengaluru Metro. Addressing the gathering, the Prime Minister said that today is a historic moment for the nation as India's first Rapid Rail Service, the Namo Bharat Train is being dedicated to the people. Shri Modi recalled laying the foundation stone for the Delhi-Ghaziabad-Meerut RRTS Corridor four years ago and marked its operation today on the Sahibabad to Duhai Depot stretch. He reiterated the government's commitment to inaugurate the projects whose foundation stones are laid and expressed confidence that he will be present to inaugurate the completion of the Meerut stretch of RRTS after one and a half years. The Prime Minister reiterated his belief that India's development lies in the development of the states. He said that two stretches of Metro will further strengthen the connectivity at the IT hub of Bengaluru. He informed that about 8 lakh passengers are traveling by Metro everyday.

The Prime Minister stressed that Namo Bharat is a glimpse of India of the future and exemplifies the transformation of the nation with growing economic muscle. The Prime Minister said that this 80 km Delhi Meerut stretch is just the beginning as the first phase will see many areas of Delhi, Uttar Pradesh, Haryana and Rajasthan being connected with Namo Bharat Train. In the coming days, Shri Modi informed that a similar system will be created in the other parts of the country to improve connectivity and create new avenues of employment. The Prime Minister emphasized the need to reduce urban pollution. This is leading to a growing network of electric buses in the country. The Central government has started a scheme of providing 10,000 electric buses to the states. He informed that the Government of India is preparing to run more than 1300 electric buses in Delhi at an expense of Rs 600 crore. Out of these, more than 850 electric buses have already started plying in Delhi. Similarly, in Bangalore also, the Government of India is providing assistance of Rs 500 crore to run more than 1200 electric buses. "The Central Government is trying to promote modern and green public transport in every city, be it Delhi, UP or Karnataka", Prime Minister said.

Hon'ble Prime Minister Mr. Narendra Modi addressed the contingent of Indian athletes who participated in the Asian Games 2022 at Major Dhyan Chand Stadium in New Delhi on 10th October 2023. He also interacted with the athletes. India won 107 medals including 28 gold medals in the Asian Games 2022 making this the best performance in terms of the total number of medals won in the continental multi-sport event. The Prime Minister said "You have created history. Figures of this Asian Games are witness to India's success. This is the best performance of India in the Asian Games to date. It is a matter of personal satisfaction that we are moving in the right direction." He recalled the doubts at the time of pursuit of Corona vaccine and said that when we succeeded in saving lives and helping 150 countries, the same feeling of moving in the right direction was experienced.

"The country has great confidence in all you players", the Prime Minister underlined as he noted the slogan of '100 Paar' that was chosen for this year's Asian Games. Prime Minister expressed confidence that this record will go much further in the next edition. Underlining that the Paris Olympics is right around the corner, the Prime Minister urged them to prepare diligently. He also consoled all those who did not achieve success this time and suggested they learn from their mistakes and make new efforts. Prime Minister extended his best wishes to all the players of the Para Asian Games which are set to begin from 22nd October.






Before 2014 Since 2014

The relationship has been nurtured by successive leadership of both the countries and this tradition is not only continuing but also expanding in many areas of mutual interests.

President of the Republic of India Hon'ble Smt. Droupadi Murmu congratulated President of the Republic of Zambia H.E. Mr. Hakainde Hichilema and the people of Zambia on the occasion of 59th Independence Anniversary of Zambia. Dr. S. Jaishankar, External Affairs Minister, Government of India also congratulated his counterpart Minister of Foreign Affairs and Intentional Cooperation Hon'ble Stanley K. Kakubo on 24th October. India - Zambia bilateral relations are historic, multi-faceted and deeply rooted in the spirit of South-South Cooperation. Among various facets of bilateral relationships, Development Partnership has become strong pillar of India-Zambia bilateral relationship encompassing various supports like lines of credit, grants, fully paid scholarship for capacity building under ITEC programme, online education through e-learning platforms etc.

India's approach to development support to Zambia is people centric and unconditional. Hon'ble Prime Minister of India Mr. Narendra Modi in his address to the Parliament of Uganda in July 2018, said, "Our development partnership will be guided by your priorities. It will be on terms that will be comfortable for you, that will liberate your potential and not constrain your future... We will build as much local capacity and create as many local opportunities as possible".

Zambia is among the most important beneficiaries of India's development cooperation programme. It includes EXIM Bank credit lines, flood relief grants, fully paid scholarships for various higher education courses, training programmes under the Indian Technical and Economic Cooperation (ITEC) and specialized capacity building programmes under India Africa Forum Summit. Some notable developmental projects undertaken in Zambia with India's assistance (LoC/Grant/Buyer's Credit) are as follows:

Lines of Credit for various development purposes

India extended an LoC worth US\$ 10 mn to Zambia in 2003 for general purposes including purchase of TATA buses, motor vehicles, motor cycles and supply of vocational tool kits. It also extended an LoC of

total US\$ 68 million for construction of 650 rural pre-fabricated health posts across Zambia in two instalments in 2013 and 2018. As on date 563 health posts have already been completed and are operational. The health posts have played a crucial role as primary health centres in the remote corners of Zambia and has helped to bring the health-care to the door-step of the people, even in the remotest part of Zambia. India has taken note of Zambia's ever growing needs of energy and partly financed 120 MW Itezhi Tezhi Hydropower Project by extending LoC worth US\$ 29 million. Itezhi Tezhi Power Corporation Limited (ITPC) is a joint venture between ZESCO Limited and The TATA Power Company Limited, incorporated on 17th August, 2007. It was commissioned in March 2016 and commenced commercial operations in May 2016. This is an example of first successful public private parthernship project in energy sector.

Buyer's Credit for Lusaka De-congestion Project

India supported the Lusaka City De-congestion Project through broadening of major roads and electrification with solar powered lights. The ground breaking ceremony of the project was jointly done by the then President of India Mr. Ram Nath Kovind and the then President of Zambia Mr. Edgar Chagwa Lungu on 12th April 2018 during State visit of the Indian President to Zambia. M/s Afcons, a subsidiary of M/s Shapoorji Pallonji group, completed the US\$ 289.5 million Lusaka City Road Decongestion Project without any time and cost over-runs. The project was financed by EXIM Bank of India under Buyer's Credit of US\$ 245.74 million. The remaining part was funded by the government of Zambia. The project has helped considerably in reduction of traffic congestion and is considered as one of the most significant contributions of India to Zambia in infrastructure sector. This project has been widely acknowledged by the Zambian leadership as well as the people of Zambia.

Gifting of medicines worth US\$ 2 million and 1000 MT of non-Basmati rice

India gifted medicines worth US\$ 2 million to Ministry of Health, Government of Zambia in December 2019 and also gifted 1000 MT of non-Basmati rice in October 2020.

e-VidyaBharti and e-ArogyaBharti (e-VBAB) Network Project

To respond to the growing demands of advance courses through electronic platforms, India offered 15,000 scholarships for students and professionals in Africa to pursue courses offered by premier Indian institutions in emerging areas as part of the Third India-Africa Summit commitments under e-VBAB network project. Zambia is the second highest beneficiary of the scheme after Nigeria and 2074 students have been enrolled for the various online courses. An e-learning centre with 25 work stations has also been established at Mulungushi University, Kabwe, Central Province.

Indian Technical and Economic Cooperation (ITEC) programme

The ITEC training programme started in 1964, is one of the most successful programme largely catering to the capacity building needs of the friendly countries. Zambians working in various Government departments have been trained under ITEC programme in various prestigious Indian institutes. About 4000 Zambians have so far been trained. New modalities like e-ITEC, ITEC-Onsite and ITEC executive have been included in the bouquet of ITEC offerings from 2018 onwards. A total of 100 Zambians have so far been trained under these online programmes. ITEC Executive has been introduced with the aim to train senior government officials in specialized programmes.

Under the ITEC Defence scheme, several senior and current serving Defence personnel have undergone training at various Defence Training Institutes in India. An e-ITEC Defence courses is expected to be introduced soon, which would focus on Information Technology and Logistics for military personnel.

Indian Council for Cultural Relations (ICCR)' Scholarship and other programmes

India has also provided scholarhsip to the Zambian student to study at higher learning institutes under ICCR's Scholarship Programme. 70 candidates from Zambia have benefited in the last 7 years. During the academic year 2023-24, 18 scholarships have been utilized by the Zambia. Prof. Chisale, Acting Vice Chancellor, Copperbelt University of Zambia under Academic Visitor Programme of ICCR visited India in March 2023 and he interacted with academicians at University of Delhi, Mumbai University and Savitribhai Phule Pune University.

To strengthen institutional relationships, an MoU to establish an ICCR Chair of Indian Studies at the University of Zambia (UNZA) was signed in April 2023 between ICCR and University of Zambia. A professor from India is soon expected to join UNZA.

India looks forward to further strengthen and expand the bilateral relations in the 60th Year of establishment of diplomatic relationship between India and Zambia and the years to come.
